FACILITY DEFINITIONS	
Bakery	An establishment whose primary operation is the manufacture and sale of baked goods, i.e., donuts, cakes, breads, etc.
Catering	Transports ready to eat food from permitted food service establishment to another location or building for service on a per event basis for hire and does not include a temporary food service event.
Drink Only	An establishment that serves alcoholic beverages and may or may not provide limited food service, i.e., frozen prepackage sandwiches, frozen pizza, hot dogs, popcorn, or any item not requiring preparation on site.
Food & Drink	An operation that stores, prepares, packages, serves, sells, vends or otherwise provides food for human consumption.
Food Mfg/Warehouse	A commercial operation that manufactures, packages, labels or stores food for human consumption and does not provide food directly to the consumer.
Food Vending	Operating food vending machines that distribute potentially only snack items or commercially prepared and wrapped foods that require little or no preparation.
Limited Food	An establishment that serves or otherwise provides only snack items or commercially prepared and wrapped foods that require little or no preparation.
Mobile Food Unit (MFU)	A vehicle mounted food establishment designed to be readily movable that returns to a commissary daily for clean up and service.
Retail	Any store, location or place of business occupied or used for the sale at retail to the public or groceries, fruits, vegetables, materials for human consumption or articles ordinarily and commonly sold from a grocery, fruit or vegetable store or stand not coming within the definition of the term "restaurant", the term "milk", the term "frozen dessert", or the term "meat".
Seasonal	The act of selling or offering for sale food items for a period of six consecutive months at a concession stand, hot dog stand, ice cream stand, etc. Valid for six consecutive months beginning on issue date.
Separate Facility Food & Drink	Additional facility types operating within the scope of a permitted establishment.
Food Vendor Permits-Temp	Permit will be issued for 3 consecutive days and shall be noted on permit questionnaire. This includes unites such as pushcarts, mobile food units and temporary food establishments such as those set up during special public events. Required for vendors within the city limits of Grand Island ONLY.
Food Vendor Permits-Annual	Any person, firm or corporation who engages in the sale of food or drink in which such food or drink is prepared, packages, served and/or sold by such person, firm or corporation from a temporary, mobile food unit, or other permitted facility and is sold or offered for sale on the streets, alleys, easements, or other public or private property in the city of Grand Island. The sale or offer of sale of freshly grown who produce shall be exempt from this definition. Required for vendors doing business in the city limits of Grand Island ONLY.
Temp. Food Establishment (TFE)	An operation that stores, prepares, packages, serves, sells, vends or otherwise provides food or drink for human consumption at a temporary location or public food event. Permit is valid for 3 consecutive days and required a separate Food Vendor Questionnaire if operating in the City of Grand Island. No more than 3 TFE permits will be issued to individuals/businesses in a calendar year.
